SONOGRAPHER-LED ULTRASOUNDS 2022

The Obstetric Ultrasound and Fetal Medicine Unit offers both a consultant and sonographer-led service. Using state-of-the-art ultrasound equipment, you and your partner can share in the experience of seeing your baby grow and mark the milestones in their development as your pregnancy progresses. All our scans and non-invasive prenatal tests can be booked individually or for your ease you can choose from one of the packages we offer below:

Obstetric Early pregnancy and dating scan

The first early ultrasound scan provides you and your consultant with important information about the number of babies and the expected date of delivery. The presence of a pregnancy and detection of the fetal heart can be seen from 6 weeks gestation by vaginal scan and from 8-9 weeks by abdominal scan. Accurate measurements and images are taken of the gestational sac, the crown to rump length of the embryo, to accurately date the pregnancy, and assess the pelvic region to exclude pathology.

Obstetric Combined screening test

The combined screening test involves serum blood screening in early pregnancy in combination with nuchal scanning and maternal age to identify pregnancies at high risk of complications/abnormalities. The combination of these factors allows the detection of about 85% of Down's syndrome cases and also those at high risk for Edwards Syndrome (Trisomy 18). This test is performed between 11.5 -13 weeks +6 days gestation and if the results show an increased risk, a diagnostic test is offered such as chorionic villus sampling from 11 weeks or amniocentesis after 15 weeks.

Non-invasive prenatal testing (Harmony and Panorama tests)

The Portland Hospital provides both the Harmony and Panorama prenatal tests. These tests are designed to detect the three common birth defects: Down's, Edwards and Patau's syndrome. These tests can be undertaken from 10 weeks gestation.

Obstetric Fetal anatomy scan

Between 19-21 weeks the anatomy of your baby is scanned in detail so that any information about the many body systems, such as the urinary tract, digestive tract, heart and major blood vessels, brain and others, can be imaged and interpreted. The careful and accurate measurements made during the scan help to monitor the wellbeing of your baby.

Growth/Reassurance Scan

Early detection of variances from a normal growth pattern enables appropriate intervention and management. A scan can assess baby's growth trend, the amount of fluid around the baby, as well as blood flow tests to indicate the placenta is working well and placental site and fetal positioning monitoring.

EARLY PREGNANCY REASSURANCE PACKAGE

The risk of miscarriage is greatest in the first 12 weeks of pregnancy. After 12 weeks there is a 98% chance of a successful pregnancy. A series of three scans usually undertaken at 7, 9 and 11 weeks can help to reassure you that all is well and the pregnancy is progressing as it should.

DOWN'S/EARLY SCREENING PACKAGE

Non-invasive screening offers the most accurate way of estimating the risk for Down syndrome (Trisomy 21), Edward's syndrome (Trisomy 18) or Patau's syndrome (Trisomy 13) coupled with the Nuchal translucency scan (including blood test). Looking at early fetal anatomy allows us to present an individualised risk for these conditions.

GROWTH REASSURANCE PACKAGE

There are strong links between poor baby growth and adverse perinatal outcomes such as stillbirth. Early detection of variances from a normal growth pattern enables appropriate intervention and management. We provide a series of three scans that will determine baby's growth trend, including monitoring the amount of fluid around the baby, blood flow tests to indicate the placenta is well, and placental site and fetal positioning monitoring.

These scans are carried out from 28 weeks and are usually undertaken at 28, 32 and 36 weeks.
